
Problem solving and reasoning questions

Make a line of 13 cubes. How many will you have if you add two more - Write the answer *before* you add them!

Sam built a tower of cubes. He took 1 off. His tower was 12 cubes tall. How tall was it before?

Start at 5. Add 2. Add 2 to your answer. Keep going like this. Do you get to 20?

Decide which order you would add each pair of cards. Write the addition.
