

Measuring with things


- 1. Find some objects that are all the same size.
- 2. Use them to measure the length of other things by lining them up end to end and counting how many there are.





Measuring with a ruler

- 1. Find the numbers on your ruler.
- 2. Put your finger on the 1.
- 3. Count 10 little lines back and that is 0. That is the beginning of your ruler.
- 4. Line the 0 up with the thing you are measuring.







