Focus: I can name the different types of teeth in humans and can explain what they do.

Use the clay to make a model of the bottom row of your teeth. Each tooth should be moulded individually. Use the mirrors to see inside your mouth and use your tongue to feel the shape of your different teeth. Ask the person next to you to check if you have made enough teeth.

Write a description of the different teeth in a human mouth. Make sure your description answers the following questions: What shape are they, where are they positioned in the mouth and what is their job? There are some words in the vocabulary box to help you.
