

A Plant and Its Seeds Poster

Instructions

- Pupils should research the information for their poster using books or the internet.
- Pupils can choose their own plant to research, but if they're stuck for ideas, some good suggestions include the plants that grow: mangoes, apples, kiwi fruits, peas, passion fruits, dragon fruits or butternut squashes.

Extension Task

Pupils could research the environment in which their chosen plant grows and the things it needs to grow well, or they could try to find out some uses of the fruit it produces. They could then write this information up in a report or produce a second poster detailing what they've learnt.

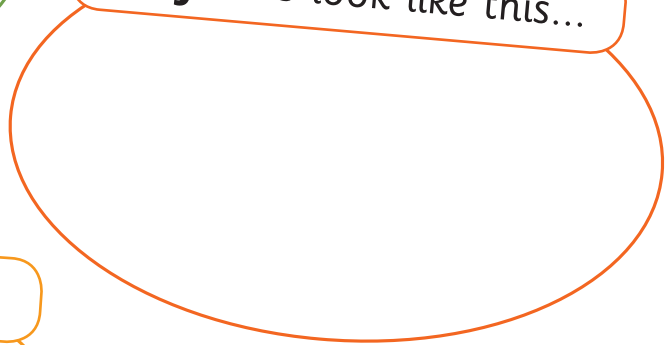
