Write 4 number sentences to relate these 3 numbers: 5, 7 and 35.

We know 8 x 5 = 40 So what is 40 ÷ 5? We know 24 ÷ 2 = 12 So what is 12 x 2?

Write a division with an answer of 5. Now write a different division using those same three numbers.

Explain in 1 sentence why you might prefer to do 5 x 9 as 9 lots of 5.

These questions should be provided for children to do once the unit has been completed. They assess the children's mastery of the skills and concepts in this unit.
