Features of Instructions

Structure & Layout:

- Clear title stating what will be done or made
- A list of materials items required to successfully follow the instructions
- Clear layout each instruction has its own line or paragraph
- Organisational features (bullet points, boxes etc.)
- Diagrams with labels
- Hints and tips or alternatives

Purpose:

 To <u>instruct</u> a reader how to <u>do</u> something

Language:

- Present tense
- Second person (usually)
- Technical vocabulary
- Often impersonal language (although some are more personal)
- Time adverbs for sequencing events (now, next, afterwards)
- Bossy imperative verbs to instruct
