| 3. | All busses travel at an average speed of 30mph on all routes |
| | (this means you will take 2 minutes to travel one mile) |
| 4. | Each town must be visited twice per day |
| | (try and see if you can visit each town once in the morning and once in the afternoon) |
| 5. | All routes must start and end in Norwich |
| 6. | No bus may travel for longer than 8 hours |
| You must fill in a timetable for the bus routes you plan and a schedule for the drivers of the busses you send around the county. | |
| You can use either 24 hour or 12 hour clock, but remember to use a.m. and p.m. if you need to. | |
