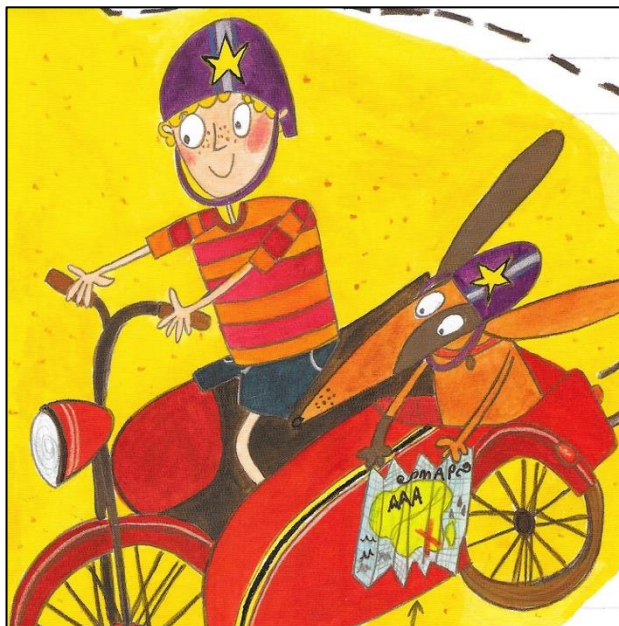


Michael's Adventures
