How Does My Device Connect to the Internet?

When the Internet was first created we needed cables to connect our computer to it.

Some cables go above ground and some go under the ground, even under the sea.

Information that is sent between computers and digital devices on the Internet, travel through these cables very fast.

How Does My Device Connect to the Internet?

A router connects to the Internet using a cable. It can then send information to your device using radio waves or wires.

Radio waves are all around us but we can't see or hear them.

Nowadays, most computers and devices can connect to the Internet without cables using radio waves. This is called a wireless network or Wi-Fi.

How Do We Stay Safe on the Internet?

The Internet contains lots of pictures, videos and information that might not be suitable for you to see.

If you see something that upsets you when using the Internet:

STOP- Stop what you are doing. Do not click on the page or reply to any messages.

CLOSE - Close the laptop, or put the tablet down.

TELL- Tell a trusted adult.

How Do We Stay Safe on the Internet?

The Internet allows us to talk to people from all over the world.

Only talk to people you know and trust on the Internet.

If someone you do not know sends you a message, speak to a trusted adult.

Do not share personal information, such as your name, address or name of your school with people on the Internet.
