
Non-Fiction Texts



Non-fiction texts...

- give you information about real people, places and things
- do not tell made-up stories but give facts
- often contain lots of photographs, diagrams and charts. These images can have labels and captions with them
- have sections that can be read in any order. You don't have to start at the beginning
- are often divided up into chapters but also have other sections like an index and a glossary, as well as headings and subheadings

Examples of non-fiction texts include: encyclopedias, instructions, diaries, biographies (the account of a real person's life) and newspaper articles.
