Write a new fable based on one read

Criteria	Description	Marks
<b>Introduce Animal Characters, choose a good story start, set Up the situation</b>	Clearly describe two animals using simple words. Make sure they fit the story theme. Pick an interesting way to begin the fable. It should catch attention and set up the story. Explain what's happening to the animals. Set the stage for the fable by describing their situation	3
<b>Describe the Setting</b>	Paint a picture of where the story happens. Use basic words and describe how it feels and sounds.	1
<b>Standard Sentence Punctuation and Speech Marks</b>	Dialogue uses basic punctuation and speech marks to indicate speech.	3
<b>Inclusion of Reporting Clause, New Line for Each Speaker</b>	Each part of dialogue is accompanied by a simple reporting clause to attribute the speech. Each new speaker is given a new line to make it clear who is speaking.	2
<b>Clarity and Coherence</b>	Dialogue is easy to understand and follows a logical sequence	1
<b>Use Descriptive Words</b>	Use describing words (adjectives) and easy images to help readers picture the characters and place.	2
<b>Use Correct Words and Sentences</b>	Write sentences the right way with capital letters and punctuation. Connect ideas with 'and' or 'but'.	1
<b>Show Creativity and Imagination</b>	Make your story interesting by creating unique characters, places, and situations.	1
<b>Make the Story Flow Well</b>	Arrange your ideas so the story makes sense. Make sure one part connects smoothly to the next.	1
