

Professor Martin's Advice for New Diggers



- ***Bring a hat to stop you getting sunburnt.***
- ***Make sure you have a large water bottle.***
- ***Wear boots so that you can walk easily through the desert.***
- ***Always carry some food with you in case you get hungry.***
- ***Keep your eyes peeled – dinosaur fossils are often very small.***
 - ***Be careful to keep a good record of everything you find.***
 - ***Ask for help if you get stuck!***

Commands

A sentence is a **command** when it is bossy and gives an order or an instruction.

Commands have bossy verbs right at the beginning or near the beginning of the sentence:

Dig for the fossil.

Never leave your tools lying around!

Command sentences begin with a capital letter.

They end with a full stop or, occasionally, an exclamation mark if the **command** is very strong.

When we read **commands** we use a strong, bossy voice.

Listen to me!

Dig as fast as you can.
