## **Professor Martin's Advice for New Diggers**

## **Commands**

A sentence is a command when it is bossy and gives an order or an instruction.

**Commands** have bossy <u>verbs</u> right at the beginning or near the beginning of the sentence:

Dig for the fossil.

Never leave your tools lying around!

**Command sentences begin with a capital letter.** 

They end with a full stop or, occasionally, an exclamation mark if the command is very strong.

When we read commands we use a strong, bossy voice.

Listen to me!

Dig as fast as you can.
