
The Key Features of Information Texts

- give you information about real people, places and things.
- do not tell made-up stories. They only have true, accurate facts in them.
- often contain lots of photographs, diagrams and charts. These images can have labels and captions with them.
- have pages with headings and subheadings on them.
- have sections that can be read in any order. You don't have to start at the beginning.
- are often divided up into chapters but also have other sections such as:

an index
