Reading Strategies

When you come across a word you don't know, use these strategies to help you read it!

Sound out the word

First strategy to use!

Break words into syllables

e.g. cat-er-piller

Look for <u>smaller</u>
words within words
e.g. *c-at*

Skip the word and read the rest of the sentence to try and work out what it says

Did the sentence you read <u>make</u> <u>sense</u>?

Use the **pictures**

Remember the text

Read the text twice – to help you remember difficult words
